Who we are

As the recognized voice of Sacramento State students, we enrich lives through experiential learning, student services, and leadership opportunities. ASI is made of students, for students, and by students.

ASI Programs (Academic Year 2018-2019; Data came from their annual report)

- Aquatic Center
 - 250 students participated in the Freshman Orientation Night.
 - 7,500 Sac State students or affiliates rented equipment.
 - 461 students attended free rental days.
- Children's Center
 - 205 children were enrolled with 105 of the children receiving state subsidies.
 - 70 fieldwork student interns from Child Development participated, totaling 2,800 practicum hours.
 - 45 hours of childcare in the evenings and Saturdays were made available for Pell Grant students.
- Peak Adventures
 - 58 trips were taken with more than 700 people served.
 - 54 FYE classes with 1,350 first-year students attending programming at the Challenge Center.
 - 5,000 pounds of trash were removed from the American River Parkway as part of Peak Adventures' River Clean Up.
- Student Engagement and Outreach
 - Approximately 540 students attended Feel Good Friday events focusing on stress-relief.
 - Approximately 7,500 visits to the ASI food pantry serving over 12,000 people.
- Student Government
 - 3,140 students voted during the ASI 2019 election.
 - More than \$117,000 for Organization and Clubs (DOC) grant funding were given.
 - \$301,428 total ASI External Grants were given to Sac State programs.
 - \$161,857 was distributed for Board of Director's Scholarships.
 - ASI Scholarships totaling
 - \$31,250 Fall - \$17,000
 - Spring – \$14,250
- Student Shop
 - 6,400 caps and gowns were sold for the 2019 graduation.
 - 27 hours of free legal aid services were provided to students.

Government Office

- 200 students registered to vote as part of the Sacramento State Vote Center.
- Over 2,400 vote-by-mail packets were dropped off.
- 588 conditional voter registrations were issued at the Sacramento State Vote Center.
