63% of respondents said 1-3 months.

18% of respondents said 3-6 months.

9% of respondents said 6 months – 1 year.

10% or respondents said over 12 months.

Note: The USDA defines food insecurity as having "limited or uncertain access to nutritious and safe foods because of a lack of money and other resources."

How often do you anticipate needing to visit the ASI Food Pantry?

31% of respondents said weekly.

33% of respondents said every other week.

20% of respondents said monthly.

8% of respondents said every other month.

8% of respondents said once a semester.
