#### **Outcomes**

#### Year 2015

- 1. Number of Participants was 213.
- 2. 60% of Summer Bridge students reached Sophomore Status after their 1<sup>st</sup> year compared to 28% for Non-Summer Bridge students.
- 3. 43% of Summer Bridge students reached Junior Status after their 2nd year compared to 23% for Non-Summer Bridge students.

#### Year 2016

- 1. Number of Participants was 217.
- 2. 68% of Summer Bridge students reached Sophomore Status after their 1<sup>st</sup> year compared to 36% for Non-Summer Bridge students.
- 3. 55% of Summer Bridge students reached Junior Status after their 2nd year compared to 26% for Non-Summer Bridge students.

#### Year 2017

- 1. Number of Participants was 222.
- 2. 58% of Summer Bridge students reached Sophomore Status after their 1<sup>st</sup> year compared to 41% for Non-Summer Bridge students.
- 3. 43% of Summer Bridge students reached Junior Status after their 2nd year compared to 31% for Non-Summer Bridge students.

### Year 2018

- 1. Number of Participants was 231.
- 2. 82% of Summer Bridge students reached Sophomore Status after their 1<sup>st</sup> year compared to 65% for Non-Summer Bridge students.

## **Pre and Post Survey with Positive Responses**

- 1. How knowledgeable are you of Sacramento State? from 64% to 100%
- 2. How well do you think Sacramento State will prepare you to accomplish your academic career goals? from 88% to 100%
- 3. How prepared are you at entering Sacramento State? from 36% to 100%
