Demographics of Students who completed the Family Friendly Survey in 2018

Gender 86% of them are female. 14% of them are male.

Ethnicity 38% of them are Whites. 25% of them are Hispanic/Latinx. 13% of them are Black/African Americans. 12% of them are Asians. 12% of them are "Other."

Class Level 36% were juniors. 49% were seniors. 10% were graduates. 5% were "other."



Age Average age is 31. Ranging from 17 to 51 years old

Employment 40% were unemployed. 38% were employed part-time. 22% were employed full-time.

Enrollment 73% were enrolled full-time. 27% were enrolled part-time.

Number of Children 55% have 1 child. 29% have 2 children. 16% have 2+ children.

Family Friendly Survey

- 46% of student-parents reported rarely being able to find child-friendly student spaces on campus.
- Top three stressors
 - o 83% keeping up with school/work assignments
 - 75% ensuring appropriate childcare
 - 75% managing money and finances
