- Greek New Member Education
 - 421 students participated in six sessions offered
 - 81% of participants said that they now feel a greater sense of personal responsibility to the larger Greek community
 - 98% of participants were able to provide all three D's in the post-assessment (Direct, Delegate, Distract) survey.

1. Leadership Initiative Program
 - a. 1862 student participants in fall 2018
 - i. 287 students completed the Green Certificate
 - ii. 64 students completed the Gold Certificate
 - iii. 3 students completed the Hornet Pride Certificate
 - iv. 1 student completed the Leadership Initiative Certificate
 - b. 1719 student participants in spring 2019
 - i. 63 students completed the Green Certificate
 - ii. 53 students completed the Gold Certificate
 - iii. 32 students completed the Hornet Pride Certificate
 - iv. 18 students completed the Leadership Initiative Certificate
2. Fall 2018 Leadership Conference
 - a. 285 student attendees
 - b. 94% strongly agree/agree to apply what they learned to be an effective leader.
 - c. 90% strongly agree/agree that they gained useable knowledge.
3. Spring 2019 Leadership Conference
 - a. 115 student attendees
 - b. 94% strongly agree/agree to apply what they learned to be an effective leader.
 - c. 87% strongly agree/agree that they gained usable knowledge.
4. iLEAD Workshop Series
 - a. 214 student attendees
 - b. 97% realized the connection between wellness and their leadership development.
 - c. 94% appreciated the activities.
 - d. 96% felt the workshop addressed the learning outcomes.
 - e. 96% felt the topics were beneficial to their overall leadership development.
5. Summer Bridge
 - a. 87% of Summer Bridge students completed the Green Certificate.
