Summer Bridge is a free six-week intensive summer academic program designed to help incoming first-time Educational Opportunity Program (EOP) freshmen make a smooth transition from high school to college.

## Retention and Graduation Rates

### Year 2015

1. Number of Participants was 213.
2. 60% of Summer Bridge students reached Sophomore Status after their 1<sup>st</sup> year compared to 28% for Non-Summer Bridge students.
3. 43% of Summer Bridge students reached Junior Status after their 2nd year compared to 23% for Non-Summer Bridge students.
4. 34% of Summer Bridge students reached Senior Status after their 3rd year compared to 41% for Non-Summer Bridge students.
5. 23% of Summer Bridge students graduated in 4 years compared to 16% for Non-Bridge students.

### Year 2016

1. Number of Participants was 217.
2. 68% of Summer Bridge students reached Sophomore Status after their 1<sup>st</sup> year compared to 36% for Non-Summer Bridge students.
3. 55% of Summer Bridge students reached Junior Status after their 2nd year compared to 26% for Non-Summer Bridge students.
4. 44% of Summer Bridge students reached Senior Status after their 3rd year compared to 45% for Non-Summer Bridge students.
5. 22% of Summer Bridge students graduated in 4 years compared to 37% for Non-Bridge students.

### Year 2017

1. Number of Participants was 222.
2. 58% of Summer Bridge students reached Sophomore Status after their 1<sup>st</sup> year compared to 41% for Non-Summer Bridge students.
3. 43% of Summer Bridge students reached Junior Status after their 2nd year compared to 31% for Non-Summer Bridge students.
4. 38% of Summer Bridge students reached Senior Status after their 3rd year compared to 33% for Non-Summer Bridge students.

### Year 2018

1. Number of Participants was 231.
2. 82% of Summer Bridge students reached Sophomore Status after their 1<sup>st</sup> year compared to 65% for Non-Summer Bridge students.

3. 63% of Summer Bridge students reached Junior Status after their 2nd year compared to 49% for Non-Summer Bridge students.

#### Year 2019

1. Number of Participants was 202.
2. 73% of Summer Bridge students reached Sophomore Status after their 1<sup>st</sup> year compared to 82% for Non-Summer Bridge students.

#### Pre and Post Survey with Positive Responses

1. How knowledgeable are you of Sacramento State? – from 60% to 98%
2. How prepared do you feel entering Sacramento State? – from 74% to 98%
3. How well do you think Sacramento State will prepare you to accomplish your academic and career goals? – from 98% to 98%
4. How involved in campus activities do you want to be? – from 90% to 95%

100% of students agreed that EOP staff was helpful.

100% of students thinks that Summer Bridge will contribute to their academic success.

72% of students were satisfied with the EOP Pre-Orientation on 6/19/2020
