Who We Are

The Full Circle Project facilitates strong academic support, intentionally planned leadership development, career readiness, and co-curricular service-learning to engage Asian Pacific Islander Desi American (APIDA) and other underserved students through campus and community-based activities.

Demographics for Cohort 8 AY19-20 (N=87)

Gender

62% of them are female.

38% of them are male.

Age

Average age was 18.2 years old.

Age ranged from 17 to 19 years old.

Class Level

98% were freshmen.

2% were sophomores.

Key Performance Indicators

Fall 2019 (n=87)

Average Term GPA was 2.66.

Average Unit Load was 16.31.

100% of students were full-time.

80% of students were enrolled with 15 units or more.

78% of students were in good academic standing.

92% was the retention rate the following semester.

Spring 2020 (n=80)

Average Term GPA was 3.08.

Average Unit Load was 14.52.

98% of students were full-time.

56% of students were enrolled with 15 units or more.

91% of students were in good academic standing.

93% was the retention rate the following semester.

Graduation Rates

- **First-Time Freshman (4-year graduation rate)**
 - a. Fall 2012 cohort (1): 3%
 - b. Fall 2013 cohort (2): 10%
 - c. Fall 2014 cohort (3): 6%
 - d. Fall 2015 cohort (4): 20%
 - e. Fall 2016 cohort (5): 24%
- **Transfer (2-year graduation rate)**
 - a. Fall 2017 cohort: 61%
 - b. Spring 2018 cohort: 61%
 - c. Fall 2018 cohort: 55%

Three Service Components

- **Academic Support**
 - Academic advising, tutoring and mentorship are all available to students.
 - Students receive support such as workshops on applying for scholarships and professionalism.
 - Second semester learning community course (ETHN 22) is available to students.
 - Students gain information of their success through enrichment and scholarly activities including the APIDA (Asian Pacific Islander Desi American) graduation celebration.
- **Programming/Events**
 - 115 students participated in the Fall Kick-off on 8/30/19
 - 90 students attended the Scholarship Forum on 9/20/19
 - 84 students attended the AAPI Identity workshop on 10/18/19
 - FCP Homecoming Tailgate
 - 88 students participated in the Fall Celebration on 12/5/19
 - 70 students attended the Community Forum: Wellness on 2/21/20
 - FCP Graduates video
 - AAPI Graduation video
 - FCP Cohort 8 video
- **Leadership Development**
 - Leadership coursework is made available to APIDA students to gain leadership skills
 - Students take part in the Leadership Initiative in partnership with Student Organizations and Leadership (SOAL)
 - Participate in cultural enrichment activities
 - Minor in Asian American Studies
