Supplemental Instruction

Fall 2019 (N=386)

Overall passing rate (C- or above course grade) of students taking SI is 89%.

Overall passing rate of students who did not take SI is 77%.

SI students who took Math 24 had an average course GPA of 2.61 compared to 1.79 for non-SI students.

SI students who took History 17B had an average course GPA of 3.27 compared to 2.70 for non-SI students.

Spring 2020 (N=197)

Overall passing rate of students taking SI is 85%.

Overall passing rate of students who did not take SI is 81%.

SI students who took Economics 1B had an average course GPA of 3.17 compared to 2.55 for non-SI students.

SI students who took Psychology 100 had an average course GPA of 3.37 compared to 2.63 for non-SI students.
