

Office of Student Conduct Data Report 2021-23

Who We Are:

The Office of Student Conduct (OSC) is responsible for administering the CSU student disciplinary process at Sacramento State. OSC reports and reviews alleged student misconduct before determining if the University will pursue disciplinary action. University discipline can be concurrent with civil or criminal actions and is a separate process from the residence hall disciplinary system.

During Covid, the Office of Student Conduct experienced the largest number of cases reviewed in a year and the data below reflects the change from online to in-person as the majority of the cases during Covid were Academic Dishonesty. Total cases over that span were 311 cases in 2017-2018, 328 cases in 2018-2019, 472 in 2019-2020 and 894 in 2020-2021.
