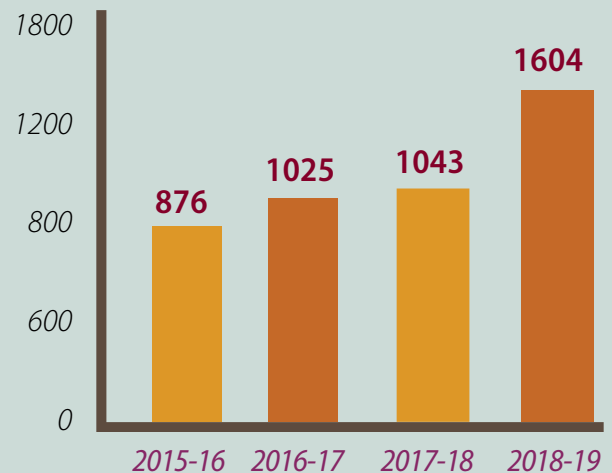

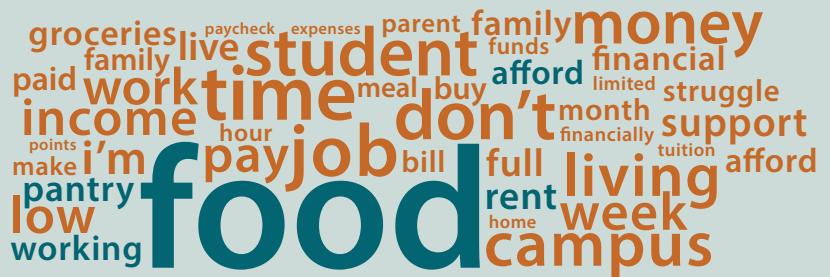

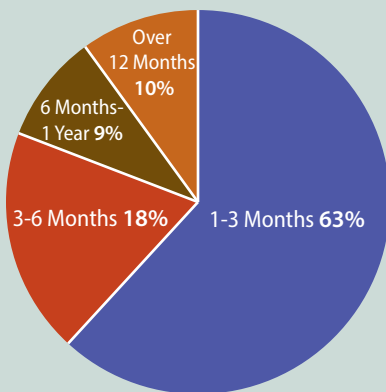

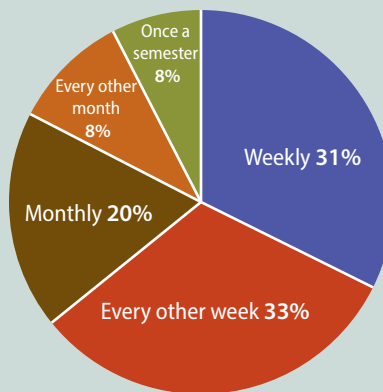
## Why Students need to utilize the ASI Food Pantry



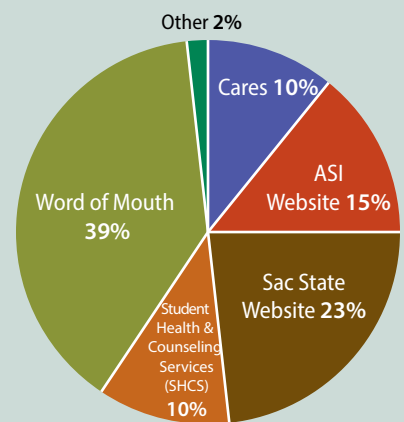
