Who We Are

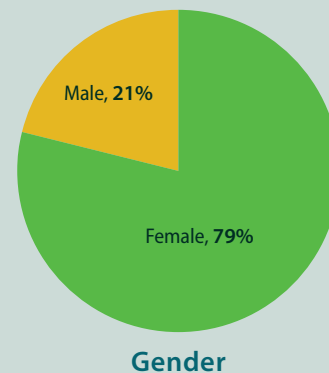
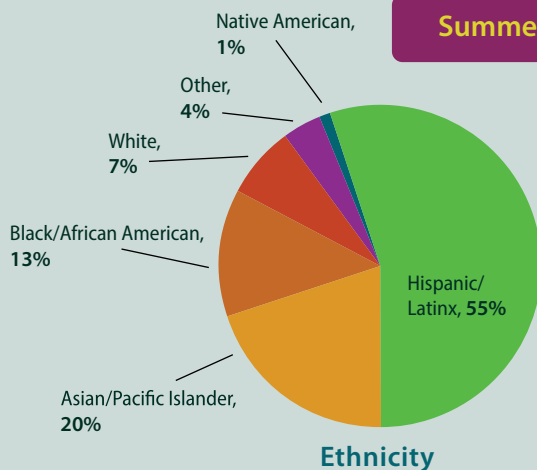

97% of students are taking 15 units or more.

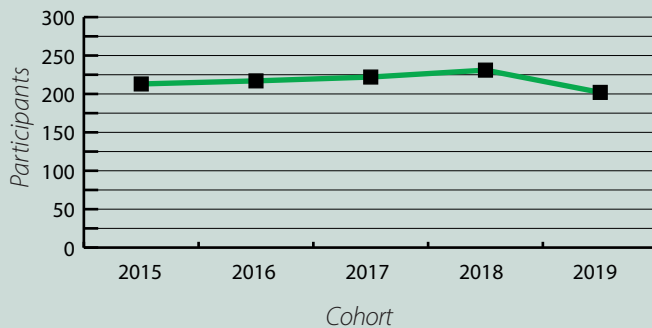
86% of students are in good academic standing.

Retention and Graduation Rates

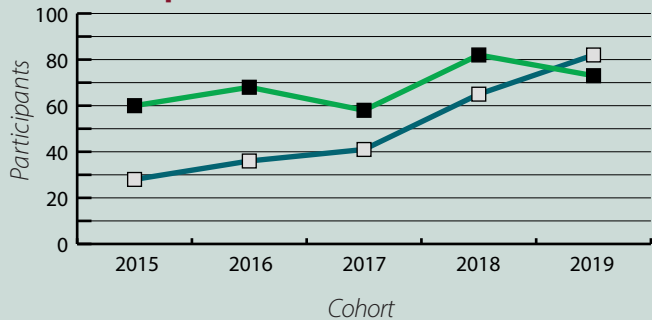
Number of Participants



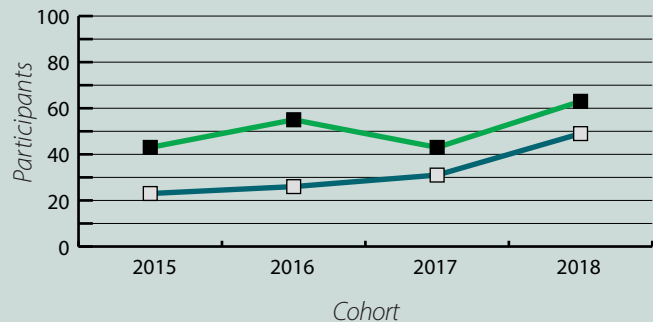
— = Summer Bridge Students
— = non-Summer Bridge Students



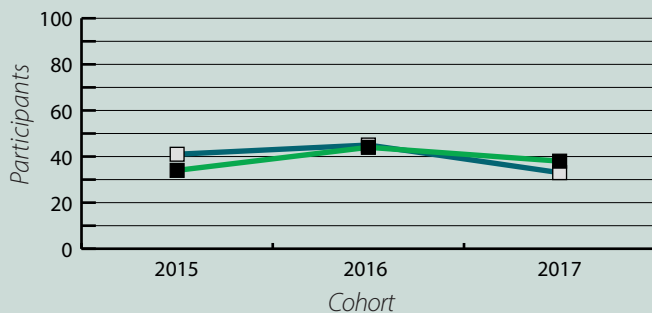
Sophomore Status after 1st Year



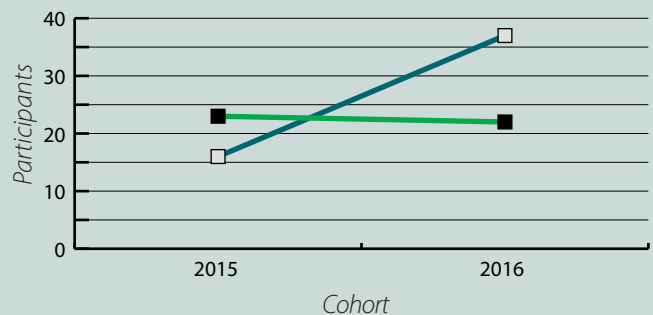
Junior Status after 2nd Year
