

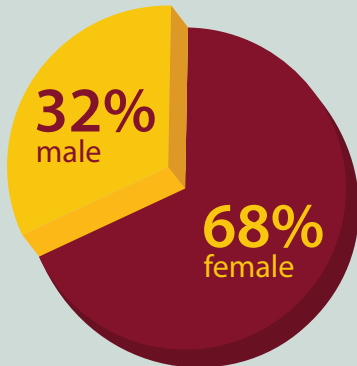
FULL CIRCLE PROJECT (FCP)

Who We Are

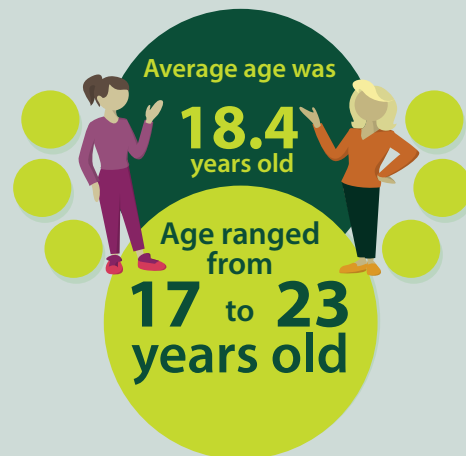

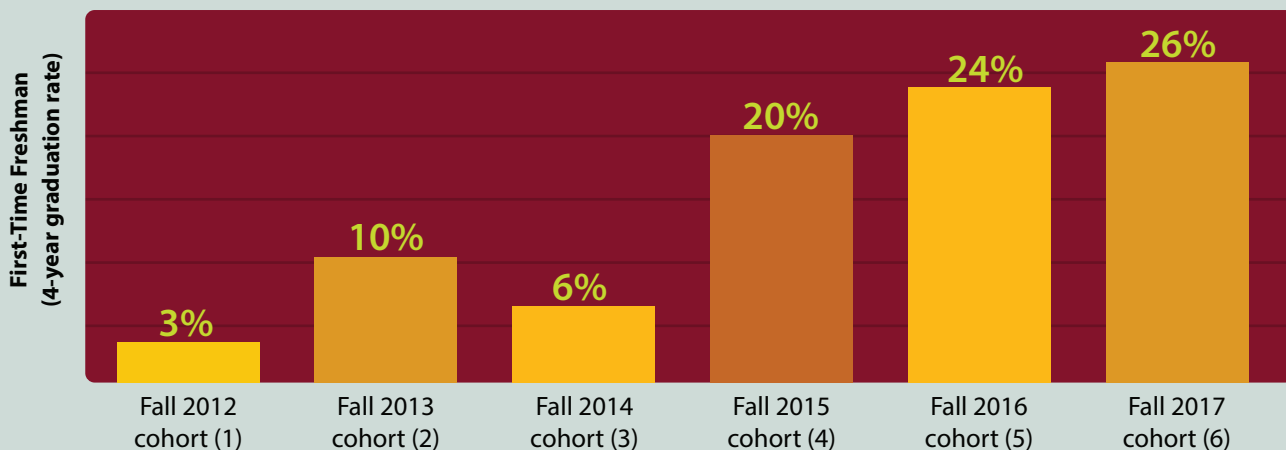
