If you are a transfer or upper-division student, there are a few things to note before applying...

- There are different options at North Village (AMC and Riverview Hall) and Hornet Commons.
- North Village and Hornet Commons provide different types and length contracts; our online housing application will explain the differences between both locations and the difference between a lease and a license agreement.
- Staff for both North Village and Hornet Commons will determine where transfer and upper-division students are placed, based on your application.

- Provide all required application information, and read all materials and attachments.
- Electronically sign and submit your application.
- You will receive a notification through your Sac State email after clicking "Submit Application."
- All communication will be sent through your Sac State email. Check your email daily.

Processing Your Application

- In 1-3 business days, you will receive an email to continue with the application process.
- **North Village:** For all first-year students or transfer and upper-division selected to live in North Village, you will complete your application by doing the following:
 - You must sign the license agreement.

- If you are under the age of 18 your parent/guardian will also need to electronically sign the License Agreement Terms and Conditions. They will receive an email link to sign the agreement.
- A \$250 application installment payment must be paid to your University account once you have completed the second portion of your housing application.
- Your application completion date is based on the date you submit the second portion of your application and pay the \$250 application installment fee.
- **Hornet Commons:** For transfer and upper-division students selected to live in Hornet Commons, you will complete your application by doing the following:
 - You must sign the lease and complete your application with Hornet Commons staff.
 - A \$50 non-refundable application fee must be paid to complete your application and lease.
 - Your application completion date is based on the date you submit the second portion of your application (including the signing of your lease) and pay the \$50 application fee.

Important Dates for 2021-2022 Application Process

March 8, 2021	Housing Application Opens at 1:00pm
May 3, 2021	Roommate Search process opens for confirmed applicants
June 11, 2021	NORTH VILLAGE ONLY: Cancellation Deadline; cancellations for any reason. Cancellation requests after this date is subject to approval.
June 11, 2021	Roommate Search ends. All roommate groups must be completed and verified.
July 15, 2021	Approximate date that Room and Roommate Assignment information will be sent to you.
July 16 – 21, 2021	Approximate dates of Room Swap process.
August 27, 2021	Halls Open for Move-In for 2021-2022 Academic Year
