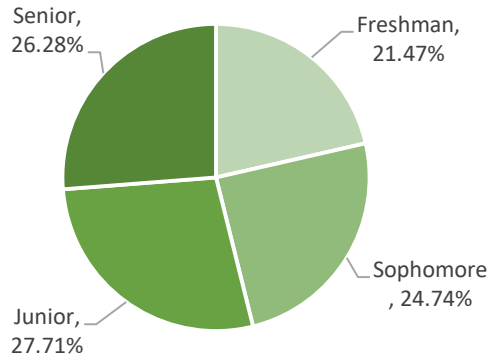
Vision Statement
