



Summer Session 2026

Summer classes are offered through the College of Continuing Education (CCE). Eligibility, class schedules, registration, and fees are determined by CCE. Visit the CCE's website for full details (www.cce.csus.edu/summer).

Who's Eligible

Continuing students: Those enrolled in Spring 2026 or Fall 2025, but will not graduate prior to Summer 2026. **Enrollment begins April 13.**

Community members: Individuals not formally admitted to the university, students who have been admitted to another college, and students who have been admitted to Sacramento State for Fall 2026. **Enrollment begins May 6.**

Sessions Offered

- **First 6-week session** (6W1) from June 1 – July 12
- **Second 6-week session** (6W2) from July 13 – August 23
- **Full 12-week session** (12W) from June 1 – August 23

Summer Registration Fees¹

Course Fees: Undergraduate: \$339 per unit | Post Baccalaureate: \$393 per unit

Campus Mandatory Fees:

Examples of how the course & campus mandatory fees are calculated:

EX: Undergraduate enrolls in 6 units → (6 units x \$339 per unit) + \$782 = \$2,474

EX: Postbaccalaureate enrolls in 3 units → (3 units x \$393 per unit) + \$782 = \$1,667

Enrolled students are subject to campus mandatory fees as a part of the summer session and cannot be waived. Fees are charged at a flat rate regardless of the number of units enrolled and it will be billed to your account in TWO parts. The course fee charges will appear on your account the day after you register. The remaining mandatory term fees will calculate later, and may take up to a week to appear on your account. Check your Student Center for the Campus Mandatory fees due date.

¹ The CSU system makes every effort to keep student costs to a minimum. Fees listed in posted schedules or student accounts may need to be increased when public funding is inadequate. Therefore, CSU must reserve the right, even after initial fee payments are made, to increase or modify any listed fees, without notice, until the date when instruction for a particular semester has begun. All CSU-listed fees should be regarded as estimates that are subject to change upon approval by The Board of Trustees.

Financial Aid

Available only for eligible continuing Sacramento State students. *New students starting in Fall 2026 are not eligible.*

Eligible students must meet the all the standard criteria below to qualify:

- ✓ Must have a 2025-26 FAFSA filed by June 30, 2026.
- ✓ Must meet [Satisfactory Academic Progress \(SAP\)](#) by the end of Spring 2026.
- ✓ Must have Pell Grant and/ or Federal Loan eligibility.

Types of Aid

Summer Pell Grant is offered to undergraduates only and eligibility is based on remaining life-time limits. Aid consideration begins upon enrollment into **one class** and should reflect on your *Student Center > View Financial Aid > 2026 award link if awarded*. Amounts will vary based on your own individual file and eligibility. **Use the Summer Pell Grant Eligibility form (Page 4) to help estimated your award amount.**

Summer Loan is offered to undergraduates **and** postbaccalaureate based on Federal Subsidized/ Unsubsidized loan eligibility. Eligible students who are interested must submit the **Summer Loan Request e-form** located on their *Student Center > Financial Aid Links section*.

- **If you were enrolled in Fall 2025/Spring 2026:** Students are encouraged to request for any unused Subsidized or Unsubsidized loans by **April 25** using the [Change in Aid eform](#). This helps the student have access to funds before the summer session begins.
