HOW DO STUDENTS SIGN UP TO SUBMIT A WPJ PORTFOLIO?

1- Complete ENGL20 or meet the requirement with an equivalent course.

2- Email **your name and student ID number** to GWAR@csus.edu

Students will receive an invitation to a Canvas course*. The Canvas course will provide instructions and guidance on creating and submitting a portfolio. The Canvas course will include video tutorials, a set of FAQs, and the self-assessment survey where you submit your portfolio.

*This is not a graded or unit bearing course.

WHAT IS THE WPJ PORTFOLIO?

The WPJ Portfolio is the best option available for students to receive a WPJ placement score. The WPJ placement score is prerequisite for enrollment in a Writing Intensive course.

The WPJ Portfolio Procedure:

1. Select 2 assignments completed for writing courses you have passed and place them in an online portfolio
2. Complete a self-evaluation survey where the final step is submitting the portfolio to receive a WPJ placement score.

Completed Portfolios submitted by the deadline will be reviewed by a team of readers who will make a recommendation for you to proceed as you prepare for a Writing Intensive course. Students will also receive a WPJ placement score and be eligible to enroll in a Writing Intensive course.
